• 1930

On September 5, according to the decision of the Council of People's Commissars of the Uzbek SSR No. 146, the Bukhara Pedagogical Institute was established.

In the initial years of the existence of this educational institution, there were only two departments - historical-social and chemical-biological, with a total of 45 students.

By 1935, BukhPI had a 2-year institute for teachers and five departments, which were later transformed into faculties. Prominent scientists such as A. Fitrat, M. Salikhov, M. Saidzhanov, B. Chupanzade, I. Kozhin, F. Trudakov, P. Korolenko, N. Merkulovich, V. Abdullaev, G. Yusupov, and others made a significant contribution to the prosperity of this institute.

• 1992

In 1992, the Bukhara Pedagogical Institute was transformed into a university and became Bukhara State University.

Bukhara State University

- Prepared 11 Doctors of Sciences (DSc) and 178 Doctors of Philosophy (PhD);
- Scientific research conducted on the basis of state grants amounted to 2.607 billion UZS, and research conducted with international grants amounted to \$495,419 USD;
- Number of foreign grants - 31, including 2 under the European Union Erasmus+ program, 1 under the DAAD program, and 3 under the FEP program in the USA.
- Number of copyright certificates is 226, with 9 patents and utility model certificates obtained;
- 1223 articles in international journals, including 118 in high-impact journals (Scopus, Web of Science) and 1320 in republican journals;
- 110 professors and teachers from prestigious foreign universities were involved;
- Published 226 textbooks, 367 monographs, and 687 educational and methodological guides;
- In all sports, 24 world champions, 31 Asian champions, and 218 champions of Uzbekistan have been trained.

BukhSU admitted its first foreign students in 2017. Many of them have now become highly qualified specialists, world-class scientists, businessmen, and entrepreneurs.

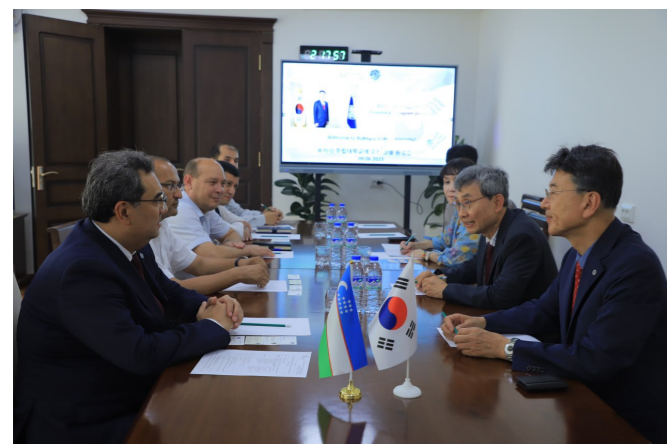
The university has a club for foreign alumni who continue to collaborate with BukhSU

The exchange of students and staff with foreign educational institutions from more than 40 countries is carried out based on international inter-university and intergovernmental agreements, as well as within the framework of international programs and projects.

Today, BukhSU is a participant in more than 10 international educational and scientific projects within programs such as:

- the European Union (5th Framework Program, "Horizon 2020," "Erasmus+," "Jean Monnet," and others), UNESCO, UNFPA,
- the Council of Europe,
- the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD),
- cooperation programs with EURASIA (Norway), and others.

Every year, BukhSU sends over 100 employees and students abroad to participate in international events, undergo training and internships, and conduct research in countries such as France, Germany, Poland, the Czech Republic, Russia, and others.



BukhSU actively collaborates with several international university networks and associations. Since 2010, the university has been a member of the European University Association.

As part of international projects with foreign partners, BukhSU modernizes educational programs, creates innovative elements of educational infrastructure, and adapts advanced international experience in teaching and learning in areas such as:

- tourism,
- information technology,
- psychology,
- hotel management, and others.

BukhSU actively implements joint educational programs with foreign partner universities for the training of specialists of I/II levels of higher education, resulting in the issuance of dual degrees. Universities from countries such as Indonesia, Russia, Bulgaria, and Israel participate in these programs. Representative offices of international organizations and centers operate on the basis of BukhSU:

- Japanese Center
- Korean Center
- Indian Center, and others.
